The historical presentation included the above mausoleum of Russell Sage, American Financier, credited with originating “puts and calls” used in buying or selling stock options on Wall Street Sage was active in the development of telegraphic communications and influential in then developing the Atlantic & Pacific Telegraphic Co. which he then consolidated into Western Union. Sue presented many such historical annotations to the history of those lying at rest in Oakwood Cemetery. We look forward towards her next presentation titled “Live Oaks & *More* Dead Folks”. **Better yet lets plan a club guided field trip to the cemetery.**
