David's Refuge was started by Warren and his wife. Who recognized the importance of sharing experiences and support during the difficult period in their lives with the loss of their son who succumbed at age 20. To a disease that from inception at age 8 until he passed on required a large support structure and intense amount of care. The initial respite came from the house that the Pfohl's built special for their son's care. The service respite is now provided in weekend retreats, and paid lodgings, free to those needing the respite opportunity.
