World Health Organization Wild Polio Virus update Week ending May 27, 2015: Afghanistan One new case of wild poliovirus this past week. For 2015 there is now 2 cases, and remains 28 for 2014. Nigeria No new cases the count for 2014 remains 6. Pakistan One new case the total cases for 2015 is now 23 and for 2014 remains 306. Ministers of Health from around the world adopted a landmark resolution to end polio once and for all at the World Health Assembly in Geneva last week.
