The People Project began in 2004 with the collaboration of two pastors in northern Peru. Their vision to begin a small school in a little town just outside of Trujillo inspired the founding team, and in 2005 they built a school and began forming their charitable organization. They have since done work in 12 nations internationally. They have reached out to over 400,000 people globally and have planted schools, churches, orphanages, and much more. It has been an honor to feed over 100,000 meals in Africa, Asia, S. America and the USA. They recently opened their first ever [community center](#) here in Syracuse!
